



Before buying a used vehicle

- ➔ Determine the total price you can pay. Also think about the cost of insurance, vehicle registration, winter tires, maintenance, fuel consumption, etc.
- ➔ Determine the type of vehicle that meets your needs.
- ➔ Take the vehicle out for a test drive.
- ➔ Have the vehicle undergo a mechanical inspection, even if the dealer claims to already have done so. An inspection at the garage of your choice is done at your expense, but it will indicate whether the vehicle needs any immediate or upcoming repairs.

Once you have found a vehicle, remember to:

- Obtain the vehicle history. You can do so in the SAAQclic. The vehicle history provides information including the number of owners and previous uses of the vehicle.

- Make sure the vehicle has not been reported as stolen by consulting the Canadian Police Information Centre
