In Canada and Quebec, tax returns are an annual obligation. Every year, employers and various organisations (government, financial, etc.) have until February 28 to provide you with the statements you need to file your tax returns.

For example, you could be eligible for various social programs and refundable tax credits that will put money straight back into your pocket. You may also be entitled to other credits that will reduce the amount of tax you have to pay, if any. These credits may include benefits for families, students, tenants and many others. Doing your taxes properly will allow you to maximise these benefits.

If you have a modest income, many organisations offer help with filing your returns. These services are often free or at low cost. Trained volunteers are available to guide you through the process.
